

Thimios Mitsiadis is Professor of Oral Biology in the Medical Faculty at the University of Zurich, Switzerland since 2006. He conducts research in the fields of stem cells, genetics, molecular and experimental biology related to orofacial developmental and regeneration processes.

Thimios Mitsiadis obtained a DDS degree from the Dental Faculty of the Kapodistrian University of Athens (Greece), a Master degree for Immunology, Genetics and Differentiation and the PhD in Developmental Biology from the University of Lyon (France). He conducted postdoctoral studies at the University of Helsinki (Finland), Karolinska Nobel Institute (Stockholm, Sweden) and Yale University (USA). Previously, Thimios Mitsiadis was a Professor at the Mediterranean University (Marseilles, France), Visiting Professor at the Ecole Normale Supérieure of Lyon (France), Clinical Senior Lecturer at King's College London (UK), Visiting Professor at the Polytechnic University of Marche (Ancona, Italy), Visiting Professor at the Second University of Napoli (Napoli, Italy).
